What this Policy covers. Please read this Cookie Policy carefully as it contains important information on who we are and how we use cookies on our website. Who we are. This website is operated by Tierna Byrne trading as Tierna Byrne Marketing & Design.

Our website. Cookies. A cookie is a small text file which is placed onto your device (for example, your computer, smartphone or other electronic device) when you use our website. We use cookies on our website. These help us recognise you and your device and store some information about your preferences or past actions. For example, we may monitor how many times you visit the website, which pages you go to, traffic data, location data and the originating domain name of your internet service provider. This information helps us to build a profile of our users. Some of this data will be aggregated or statistical, which means that we will not be able to identify you individually.

We may use the following cookies:

- Strictly necessary cookies. These are cookies that are required for the operation of our
 website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our
 website, use a shopping cart or make use of e-billing services.
- Analytical / performance cookies. These are cookies that allow us to recognise and count the
 number of visitors to our website and to see how visitors move around our website when they
 are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that
 visitors are finding what they are looking for easily.
- **Functionality cookies.** These are cookies that are used to recognise you when you return to our website. This enables us to personalise our content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).
- Targeting cookies. These are cookies that record your visit to our website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. We will use this information to make our website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information with third parties for this purpose.
